

HOUSE RULES

GUEST'S RESPONSIBILITIES AND HOUSE RULES.

Thank you for choosing to be our guest at Christina Lake Lodge. To make your stay comfortable and safe we would appreciate your cooperation in following the responsibilities and rules listed below.

All dishes, pots and pans should be washed and put away.

Sink, Stove, BBQ, Microwave, and Fridge should be cleaned and wiped down.

Please do not pour grease down the sinks or toilets. It causes blockage and back up of sewage into the cabins and that is no fun for anyone.

The deck area should be left tidy. Please put garbage in the designated green garbage bin on the deck.

Fire pits. Do not leave fires burning unattended. Please clean up garbage/items around the pit. If you choose to use the deck chairs, make sure to return them when finished.

All pets must be on a leash while outside of the cabin. Please pick up after your pet's droppings. Guests are responsible for any damage caused by their pets. Do not leave pet food/bones outside at night. Any guests that have aggressive pets that cause issues will not receive a warning and will be asked to leave immediately.

NO FOOD, GARBAGE, PET FOOD/BONES, USED COOKING UTENSILS can be left outside at night. We do not want uninvited guests such as mice or bears.

We do not sell fishing licenses. You can purchase them on the AlbertaRELM mobile app. There is a posting of the fish catch regulations in the office. Anyone caught keeping unauthorized fish will be reported for poaching.

Check out time is 11:00am. Please leave your key on the dinning room table. Any keys missing or lost are partial to a \$50 replacement fee.

Boat moorage is available if there is space – \$50 per day.

There is absolutely NO FISHING OR SWIMMING permitted on the private dock under any circumstance. The private dock is the dock on the left side with the big sign that says Private Dock.

Erection of tents is not permitted in front of or around the cabins. Small sunshades and bug screens are permitted but must be taken down at night. Please speak to us first before setting up any bouncy castles.

All visitors must sign in at the office. Visiting hours end at 10:00pm.

Quiet time is at 11:00pm to 7:00am. This includes music, shouting, loud talking, riding ATV's/dirt bikes, chopping wood, etc. Please be respectful of the other guests.

All ATV/Dirt bike riders must wear a proper helmet while on Christina Lake Lodge property. Bike helmets do not qualify.

NO FIREWORKS OR FIREARMS are allowed on the property.

There is NO SMOKING permitted in the cabins. Please dispose of your butts in the butt out cans provided on the deck of you cabin.

Failure to comply with the above responsibilities/rules will result in additional charges ranging from \$25-\$250.
